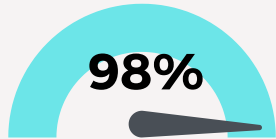
Our Mission: To help our members, and the communities we serve, be healthy

98% of all PHC contracted providers indicated they were satisfied with our services.



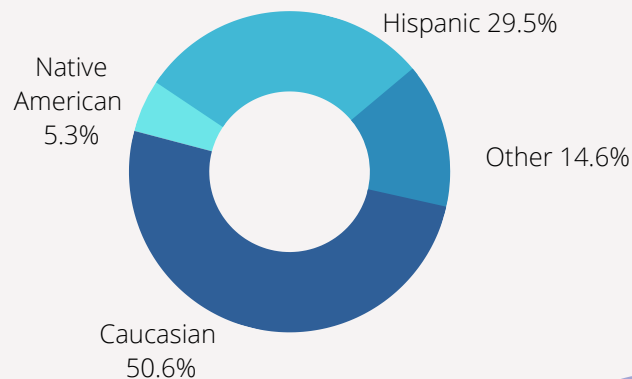
Our Quality Improvement Program distributed \$2.8 million to health care providers to improve and expand services.

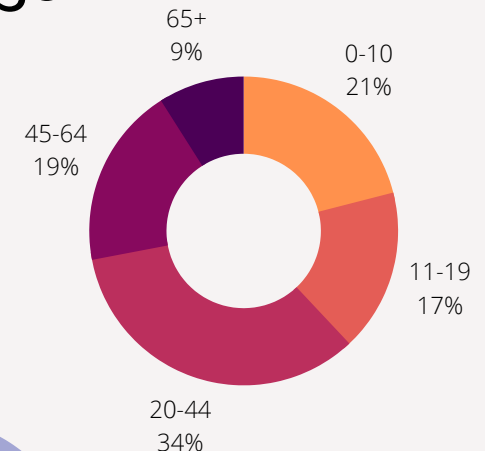

Age



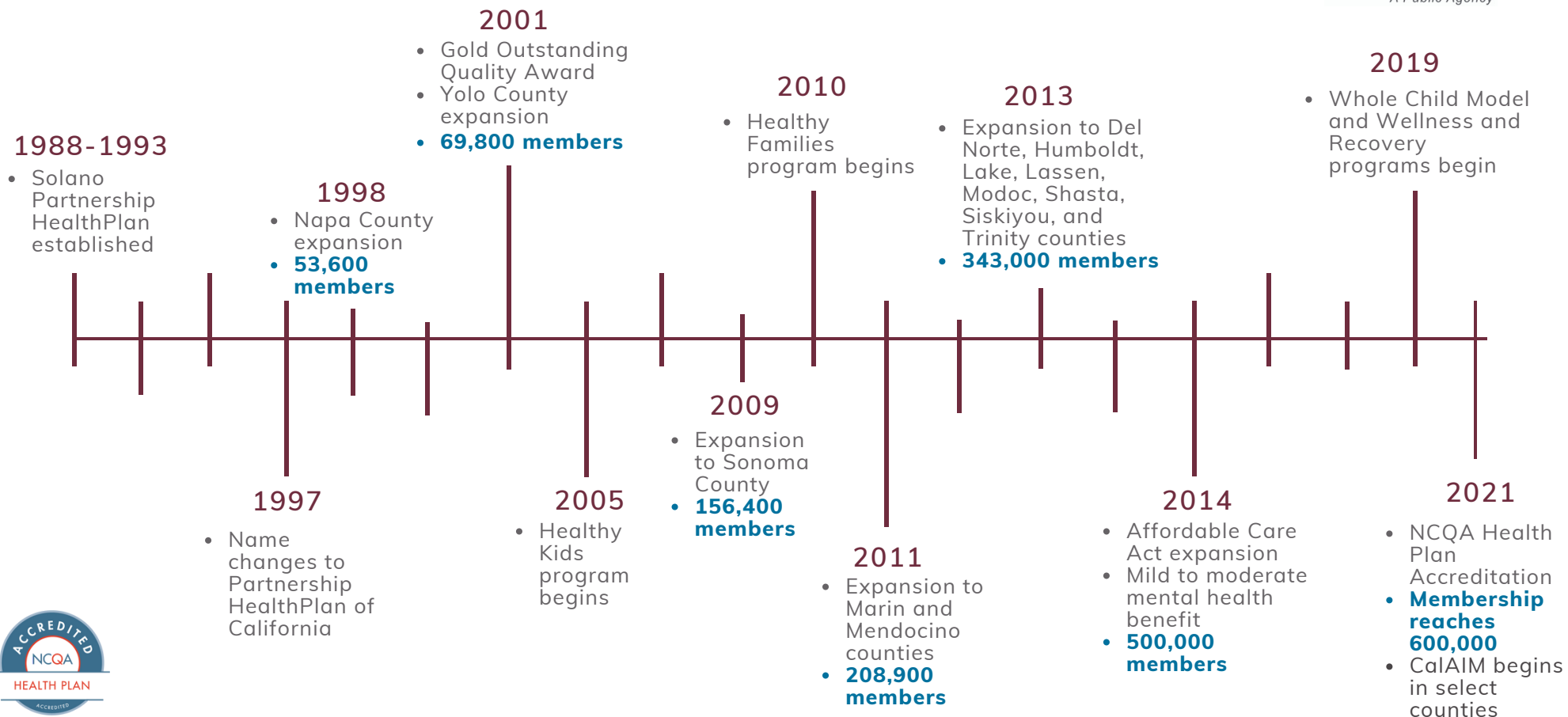
