CalWORKs Homeless Assistance program

“The CalWORKs Homeless Assistance program serves CalWORKs recipients who are homeless or at risk of homelessness.

CalWORKs recipients, or applicants who appear to be eligible to CalWORKs, who meet the criteria for being homeless, are eligible for Temporary Homeless Assistance to stay in temporary shelter (e.g., a motel) for up to 16 days. Following the 16-days, the temporary shelter benefit is considered exhausted.”
