“I can’t pay my rent between September 1, 2020 and September 30, 2021”. You can never be evicted for rent you couldn’t pay between September 1, 2020 and September 30, 2021 if you: Couldn’t pay rent for COVID-19 reasons, and Sign and Return the declaration form every time you landlord asks you to within Fifteen day, and Pay at least 25% of your September 2020-September 2021 total rent by September 30, 2021 OR apply and receive 100% rent help from California. Total rent means our rent and any charges you pay your landlord, such as utilities.

“I can’t pay my rent because of COVID. Can I be evicted?” Probably not. If you have been unable to pay rent for any time since March 1, 2020, your landlord is required to give you a 15-day notice. This new notice must give you 15 days to pay rent or tell the landlord that you cannot pay because of COVID. Your landlord will give you a form called a “Declaration” with the 15-day notice. You need to give the completed declaration to your landlord within 15 days.
