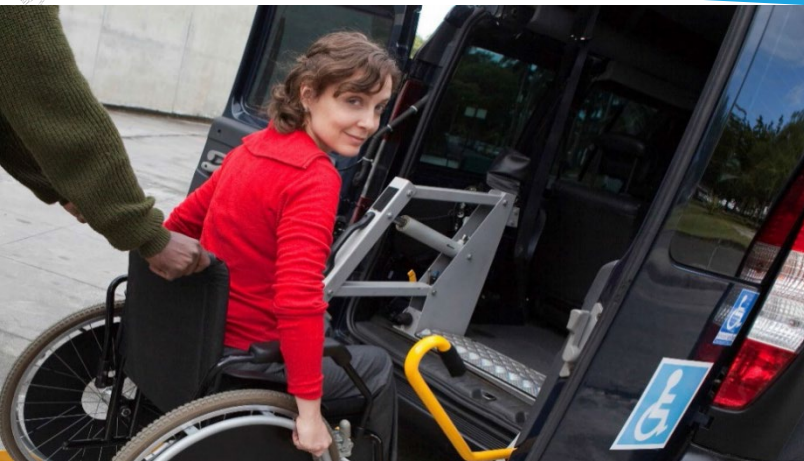

“Senior (65+)/Disabled/Medicare (SDM) passengers qualify for the reduced fare rate on all the local and intercity FAST buses. You may pay the reduced bus fare by showing one of the following forms of ID when purchasing an SDM pass and boarding the bus [qualifying forms of ID are listed on website].”
