

Prop 56: Behavioral Health Integration Grants

Behavioral Health Integration Grants Webinar

The 2019 California Budget Act authorized \$140 million¹ over three years to implement the Behavioral Health Integration Incentive Program. Funded projects should aim to improve physical and behavioral health outcomes, care delivery efficiency and patient experience using culturally, and linguistically appropriate providers with expertise in primary care, substance use disorder and/or mental health conditions.

Who is eligible: Primary care, specialty care, hospital based and behavioral health providers (both mental health and substance use) who deliver services to Medi-Cal beneficiaries and have a current provider contract with PHC or with Beacon Health Options, or who will have a contract with PHC or Beacon by January 21, 2020. ***FQHCs, RHCs, and IHS providers are eligible to apply. County providers are also eligible to apply.***
