Formulary Navigator- PHC Online Formulary Search Tool-

PHC hosts our own online formulary search tool which provides current and comprehensive coverage information for medications on our formulary and those drugs with TAR criteria. Information on carved-out drugs is also included. In addition to the formulary status, PHC's online formulary search tool can categorize search by therapeutic class, provide information on formulary alternatives when a medication is not covered, and many other features. Filling insulin pen prescriptions

Remind your patients not to use their insulin pen past the expiration date printed on the label or for more than 28 days after they first start using the pen. When calculating the day supply, it is important to consider the daily dose and keep in mind that each pen will last for 28 days after opened. Using the correct calculated day supply will ensure the prescription is appropriately billed.
