There are 6,300 Partnership members in Mendocino County who are low-income seniors or people with disabilities.

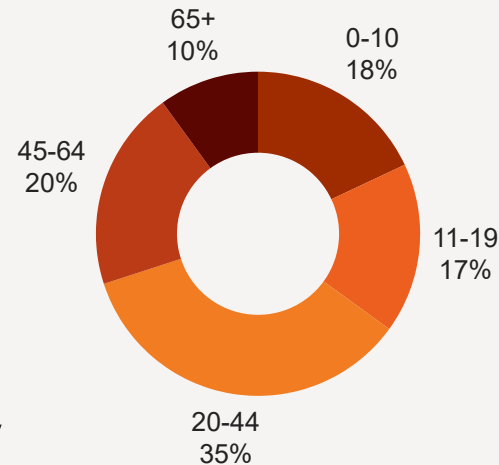


For CalAIM, there are 22 Community Supports (CS) providers and 33 Enhanced Care Management (ECM) providers in Mendocino County.

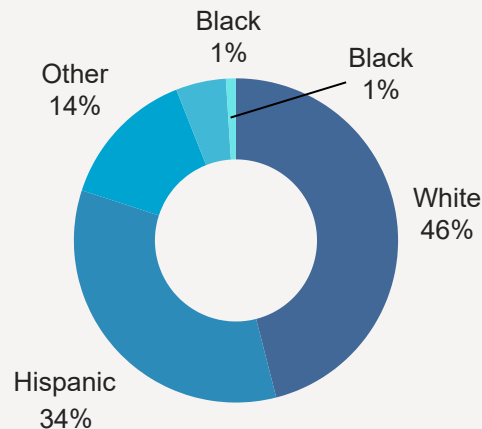

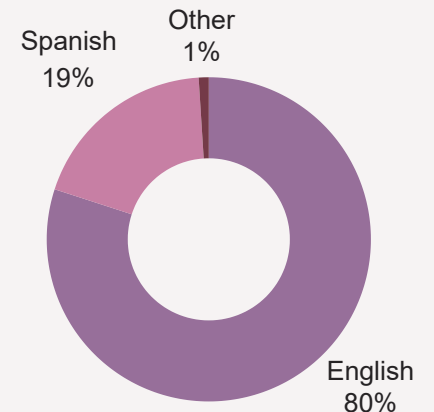

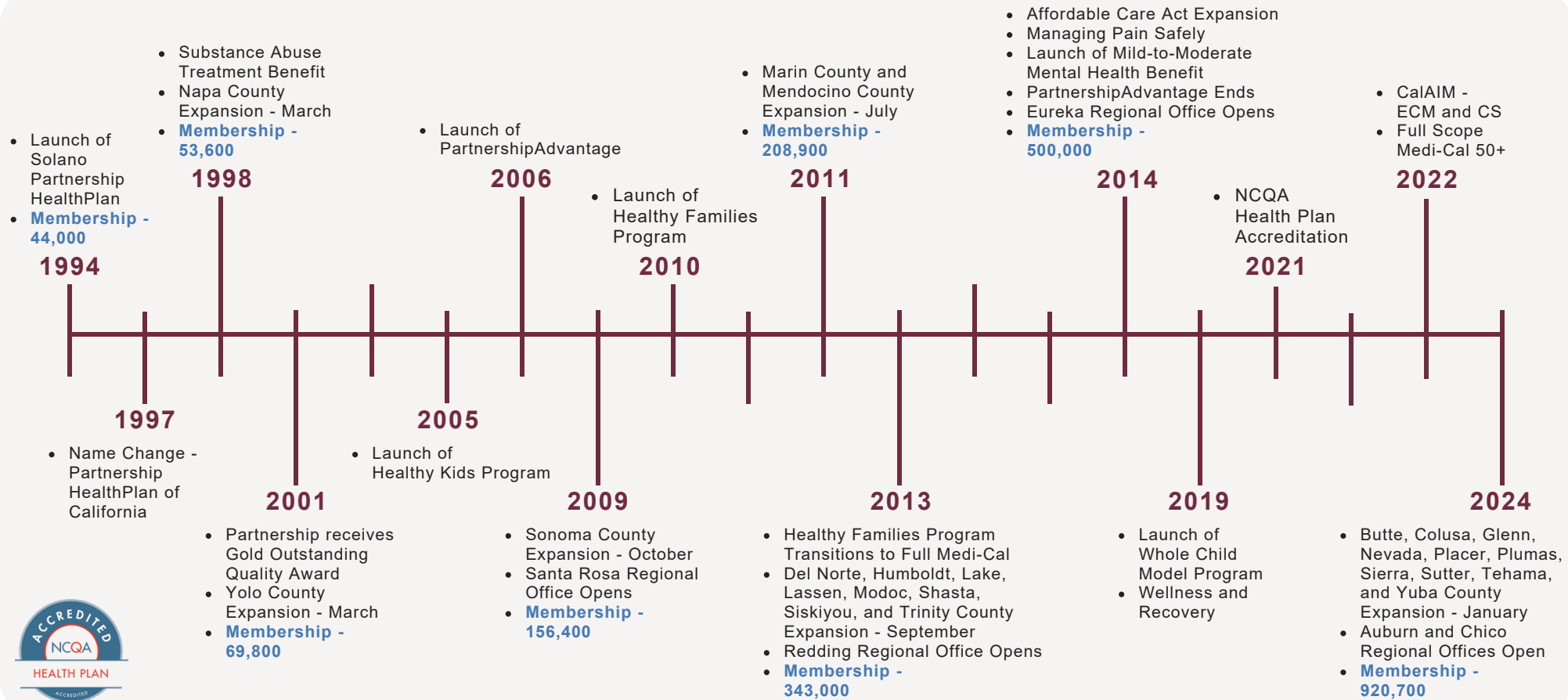
