

New Benefit for Members: Enhanced Care Management

Enhanced Care Management (ECM) connects you to lead care managers who can help you get health care and services.

To get ECM, you must be a Partnership member. You also must have one or more of the following be true:

- At risk for hospital or emergency stay that could be avoided
- Do not have a home
- Have severe mental illness and/or want to stop using drugs or alcohol
- In the justice system (prison, jail, juvenile hall) who are moving back into everyday life in the community
- At risk for going to a long-term care place
- Moving from a nursing home to the community
- Signed up for California Children's Services or Whole Child Model
- In Child Welfare
- Have special needs
- African American, Native American, and/or Pacific Islander AND are pregnant or have a new baby

How do I sign up?

- Help dealing with drug and alcohol misuse
- Help find housing for adults and children
