### Community Resource Project - HEAP

“The Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) is a utility payment program that can offer income-eligible residents of Sacramento, Sutter, and Yuba Counties a credit to their energy and/or water/wastewater bills. HEAP is available for customers of PG&E, SMUD, and major wastewater/water providers, and for those who heat their homes using wood, propane, or oil purchased from a vendor.”
