Subject: Change in Billing of Azithromycin

Effective for dates of <u>submission</u> on or after 8/1/2023, Partnership HealthPlan of California (PHC) will only require Q0144 (Azithromycin oral capsules/powder, 1 g) for the 1 gram powder packets. Since capsules are no longer marketed, the use of Q0144 solely for the oral powder packets correlates with industry standards based on the code description. Azithromycin tablets and suspension will be accepted only with J3490/Z7610.
