



Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnostic and Treatment Training Requirement

September 2024

Attention, network providers: **REMINDER**

As of January 1, 2024, the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) required all managed care plans to ensure network providers complete Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnostic and Treatment (EPSDT) specific training no less than every two years.

In order to stay compliant with DHCS, **Partnership HealthPlan of California is requesting all contracted medical groups/providers that provide services to members under the age of 21 to complete and return a signed attestation.** To prevent duplicate efforts, if you are contracted with multiple managed care plans and have completed the training for all of them, you may share your training records and provide an attestation of completion.

If you have not submitted an attestation for EPSDT training, please do so at your earliest convenience. If you have already submitted an attestation, please disregard this notice.
