Partnership HealthPlan of California is offering the opportunity to retrieve medical records from your site for the Healthcare Effectiveness Data and Information Set (HEDIS®) via Electronic Medical Record (EMR) Remote Access through our vendor. If your provider group is considering signing up for HEDIS MY2024 EMR Remote Retrieval, please review the following technical guidelines to determine if your system has the required capabilities.

Technical Guidelines of HEDIS MY2024 EMR Remote Retrieval:	
\square Permission/set-up that allows the retrieval vendor to print to PDF to secure remote desktop environment	
☐ Read-only access set-up for your EMR	
□ The ability to set up and maintain remote access for retrieval nurses□ The ability to maintain access from January through the beginning of June 2025	
EMR Remote Retrieval Vendor Preferred Access Capabilities — "Test Patient" set-up in EMR for testing — User Access forms (multiple users) — Training available on how to navigate EMR / where to find HEDIS documentation — If you need to bucket charts for your organization, please communicate this to Partnership. — Access/training documents/reference guides, if available — All Credentials set-up for users (Ex: Remote Desktop credentials and EMR credentials) — Redirected printing	EMR Remote Access should include the following: Demographic information Problem List Medication Sheet History and Physicals Consult Notes Functional Assessment Labs Progress Notes Immunization Records Obstetrics Flow Sheets Scanned documents such as Staying Healthy Assessments NOTE: Mental Health Records should NOT be included in access
