


Measurement Year 2023 (MY2023) / Reporting Year 2024 (RY2024)

- HEDIS<sup>®</sup> Hybrid Measure: Data collected from both Administrative sources (claims, lab data, etc.) and abstracted from patient medical charts (paper and EMR).
- <u>Health Plan Accreditation (HPA) Measure</u>: Uses HEDIS data to effectively measure the Health Plan's care and service performance, which determines the Health Plan's Star Rating.
- <u>Medi-Cal Managed Care Accountability Set (MCAS)</u>: Uses HEDIS data to effectively measure the Health Plan's care and service performance.

The following measures are applicable to both HPA and MCAS Reporting \*unless otherwise noted.

CIS-10 Childhood Immunization Status – Combination 10	Percentage of children 2 years of age who receive a series of vaccines (# of injections) by their second birthday: DTaP (4)	<ul> <li>All immunization records (IZ grids, CAIR, other registries)</li> <li>Birth – 2023 Progress / Office Visit notes</li> <li>CHDP forms</li> <li>Hospital birth record (includes IZ given at birth)</li> <li>Birth – 2023 Day Care Exams</li> <li>Evidence of contraindication for the vaccine</li> <li>Evidence of the illness for MMR, Hepatitis B, VZV (chicken pox), Hepatitis A</li> <li>Evidence of anaphylaxis due to any of the listed vaccines</li> <li>Evidence of parental/guardian refusal of immunization</li> <li>Evidence of LAIV (live attenuated influenza vaccine) administration which occurred <u>on</u> the child's second birthday</li> <li>Evidence member was admitted to or used hospice service, or died in 2023</li> <li>2023 Updated Problem Lists / Medical History</li> </ul>

IMA-2 Immunization for Adolescents – Combination 2	<ul> <li>Percentage of adolescents 13 years of age during the measurement year who had the following:</li> <li>1 Meningococcal vaccine between 11-13 years old</li> <li>1 Tetanus, diphtheria toxoids and acellular pertussis vaccine (Tdap/Td) between 10-13 years old</li> <li>2 or 3 human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccines between 9-13 years old</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>All immunization records (IZ grids, CAIR, other registries)</li> <li>2019 – 2023 Progress / Office Visit notes</li> <li>CHDP forms</li> <li>Sports physical notes</li> <li>Evidence of contraindication for the vaccine</li> <li>Evidence of parental/guardian refusal of immunization</li> <li>Evidence of 2-dose HPV vaccine series with at least 146 days between the first and second dose, or 3-dose HPV vaccine series</li> <li>Evidence member was admitted to or used hospice service, or died in 2023</li> <li>2023 Updated Problem Lists / Medical History</li> </ul>

WCC Weight Assessment and Counseling for Nutrition and Physical Activity for Children/ Adolescents	Percentage of members 3-17 years of age who had an outpatient visit with a PCP or OB/GYN and who had evidence of the following during the measurement year: • BMI percentile documentation <i>*HPA only</i>	<ul> <li>2023 Progress / Office Visit notes (including sick visits)</li> <li>2023 Well Child check sheets</li> <li>2023 CHDP forms</li> <li>2023 ED / Inpatient / Urgent Care records</li> <li>2023 Notes from telephone visits, e-visits (i.e. secure text messaging or email, patient portal) and virtual check-ins</li> <li>Flowchart / Vital Signs Record (including weight, height, &amp; BMI percentile)</li> <li>Age-growth chart</li> <li>2023 Documentation of weight or obesity counseling</li> <li>2023 Documentation of services rendered during a telephone visit, e-visit (i.e. secure text messaging or email, patient portal) and virtual check-ins</li> <li>Evidence member was admitted to or used hospice services, or died in 2023</li> </ul>

CCS Cervical Cancer Screening	<ul> <li>Percentage of women 21-64 years of age (as of December 31 of the measurement year) who were screened for cervical cancer:</li> <li><u>21-64 years:</u> Cervical Cytology within the last 3 years</li> <li><u>30-64 years:</u> Cervical high-risk human papillomavirus (hrHPV) testing within the last 5 years</li> <li><u>30-64 years:</u> Cervical Cytology with hrHPV co-testing within the last 5 years</li> <li>For hrHPV, the <i>minimal age at the date of testing is 30 years.</i></li> </ul>	<ul> <li>2019 – 2023 Cytology Reports (Pap, Pap and hrHPV / HPV tests date and results)</li> <li>2019 – 2023 OB/GYN Consults</li> <li>2019 – 2023 Progress / Office Visit notes</li> <li>2019 – 2023 Preventive health screening form with Pap, Pap and hrHPV / HPV tests date and results</li> <li>2023 Updated Problem Lists / Medical History</li> <li>Name of patient's OB/GYN Provider</li> <li>Surgical history, include pathology reports for hysterectomy</li> <li>History of Vaginal / Total / Complete / Radical hysterectomy on or prior to 12/31/2023</li> <li>Evidence member was admitted to or used hospice services or palliative care, or died in 2023</li> </ul>

PPC Prenatal & Postpartum Care	<ul> <li>Percentage of deliveries of live births on or between October 8, 2022 and October 7, 2023. The measure assesses the following indicators:</li> <li><u>Timeliness of Prenatal Care:</u> The percentage of deliveries that received a prenatal visit in the first trimester, on or before the enrollment start date or within 42 days of enrollment to PHC</li> <li><u>Postpartum Care:</u> The percentage of deliveries that had a postpartum visit on or between 7 and 84 days after delivery</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>2022 – 2023 Progress Notes / Office Visit notes including PCP, OB flow sheet, and labs</li> <li>2022 – 2023 Notes from telephone visits, e-visits (i.e. secure text messaging or email, patient portal) and virtual check-ins</li> <li>2022 – 2023 Prenatal flowsheet/prenatal history/labs (OB Panel, TORCH antibody panel, Rubella antibody test/ABO/Rh)</li> <li>Name of patient's OB/GYN provider / referrals to OB</li> <li>2022 – 2023 All prenatal and postpartum records (including records prior to PHC enrollment, telehealth and in-person office visits)</li> <li>2022 – 2023 Diagnosis of pregnancy, documentation of delivery date, delivery medical record</li> <li>2022 – 2023 Ultrasound report(s)</li> <li>Prenatal risk assessment form</li> <li>Evidence of any of the following: member was not pregnant, the pregnancy did not result in live birth, or member did not deliver between October 8, 2022 and October 7, 2023</li> <li>Evidence member was admitted to or used hospice services, or died in 2023</li> </ul>
