

Primary Care Provider Quality Incentive Program (PCP QIP) Background

- The PCP QIP is a Pay-For-Performance (P4P) program that provides financial incentives for driving quality health outcomes for PHC members
- We offer measure performance reporting, member data, training and technical assistance
- All Primary Care Providers with Medi-Cal assigned members are automatically enrolled
- PCP program is structured by Core Measurement Set and Unit of Service Measures
- Measurement Year 2022 PCP QIP P4P Highlights
 - ✤ 264 Provider Sites from 103 Parent Organizations
 - About \$38.3 million distributed incentives



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Timeline Terms

- Continuous Enrollment requires members to be assigned to your parent organization for 9 out of 12 months Between Jan 1, 2023 and Dec 31, 2023. Sites where member(s) is assigned as of Dec. 1st will be an "anchor" for inclusion in final denominators
- Exclusion Deadline last day to submit clinical and small denominator exclusions request
- Grace Period timeframe after the end of measurement year, to submit data for members in final denominators
- Validation Period timeframe after the Grace Period, to review and validate uploads and final rates





Important 2023 Measurement Year Closeout Dates


DATE	EVENT
December 31, 2023	End of Measurement Year.
January 1 st – 8 th , 2024	eReports under maintenance. No provider access to eReports or Partnership Quality Dashboard (PQD).
January 9, 2024	eReports, with your final denominators, is available.
January 9 th - 31 st , 2024	Grace Period to upload data on services delivered between January 1 and December 31, 2023.
January 15 th – 31 st , 2024	Submissions for small denominator exclusions
January 31, 2024, by 5pm (close of business)	Last day to submit clinical measure & small denominator exclusions and upload data for the 2023 PCP QIP.
February 1 st – 8 th , 2024	Validation Period: eReports frozen so providers can review final rates inclusive of uploads.
