

Preventive Care Reports

WHO: This guide is intended for eReports users who participate in Partnership's Primary Care Provider Quality Incentive Program (PCP QIP).

WHAT: Preventive care reports provide detailed data for the following PCP QIP measures: child and adolescent well-care, well-child visits in the first 15 months, well-child visits in the first 15-30 months, childhood immunization status, and immunizations for adolescents.

WHY: Preventive care reports display member contact information, existing immunizations, and dates of service for well-visits. These reports support efforts to perform member outreach and close care gaps. Partnership recommends accessing reports early in the year (prior to the launch of eReports) to help initiate measure quality improvement efforts.

Accessing the Preventive Care Dashboard:

1. Log into the Partnership eReports page here.



- 2. Enter your username and password.
 - a. If you are a new user, email the PCP QIP team at <u>QIP@partnershiphp.org</u> for your site's registration key.
 - b. If you forgot your password, select "Can't access your account?" on the login page. You will receive an email to reset your password.




Preventive Care Reports

3. From the eReports threshold report screen, select "Preventive Care Reports" from the option menu on the left-hand side.

This will take you to the Preventive Care Report Summary Information dashboard which includes:

- Overview of reports
- Recommended use of reports
- Important notes
- FAQs

Preventive Care Reports

These reports are supplemental to eReports and do not indicate measure compliance. The source of data is Partnership administrative data only. Dates of service that have been uploaded into e-Reports are not visible in these reports.

The intent of the immunization dose reports is to enhance visibility of immunizations given, including for members not yet in the annual denominators for the Childhood immunization Status and Immunizations for Adolescents measures. Data sources for this report include California Immunization Registry (CAIR) data, Partnership's claims and encounter data, and immunization data received through Partnership's Clinical Data Repository.

Well Care Reports

Like the Immunization Reports, Well Care reports promote visibility of well visits completed for members who are not yet in the denominator for the Well Child Visits in the First 15 Months, Well Child Visits in the First 15 – 30 Months and the Child and Adolescent Well Care measures. The data source for these reports in Partnership's claims and encounter data. Note that dates of service must be a minimum of 14 days apart to count towards numerator compliance.

Use reports to engage with members sooner, to help keep members on track with recommended immunization schedules and well-care visits.

- Review service dates against measure requirements, to determine if members still require additional dates of service before aging out of the measur - If immunization dates

ization dates of service are not captured on this report, please report them in CAIR. This will help to ensure data is inistratively captured in e-Reports

Reports may not include recent dates of service due to claims lag (up to 3 months) and the timeframe by which Partnership ntegrates CAIR data (typically a 4 to 6 week lag).

Duplicate immunization dates, or dates of service close in time may be represented as separate immunizations on the report, depending on how records were entered in CAIR or services were billed. Confirm all service dates in e-Reports and aga measure specifications to ensure compliance. - No upload data from e-Reports is captured in this dashboard

Frequenty Asked Questions

- Q. Members with letter "E" in their Client ID Number (CIN) show up with scientific notation formatting when I download the
- A. This is due to Excel's auto-formatting. To fix this, open a new workbook and import the downloaded immunization report as text file.
 - Select the Data tab from the ribbo

 - Select From Text under Get External Data menu Locate your report from the folder it was downloaded to. Click Import.

 - Use the Import Wizard to import the file
 Step 1. Delimited data type (Next)
 Step 2. Tab delimited check (Next)
 Step 3. Highlight the column for CIN and change the column data format to Text (Finish, OK)
- Q. Why are there more or less columns in the report for each vaccine-type than number of doses required for the series?

 A. The number of immunization columns reflects the maximum number of dates of service for any given member in the report. If none of the members had any doses under a vaccine-type, there will be no placeholder columns for that vaccine. If a ngle member had many different dose dates under a series, that number of columns will display under the series. To confirm the number of required doses in a series refer to the QIP measure specifications document for Childhood Immunization Status and Immunizations for Adolescents measures.
- Q. The columns showing dates of service are not in a standard date format when I export the dose report.
 A. To fix this, highlight all columns in the exported report that should show dates of service. On the Excel ribbon, change the format from General to Short Date.
- Q. What does "NULL" mean in the report(s)?
 A. NULL means there is no data available to report for that metric.







Preventive Care Reports

Childhood Immunization Status - Combo 10 (CIS-10):

This dashboard displays a vaccine dose report of immunization data for members in the CIS-10 denominator for the current measurement year and for members not yet in the annual denominator. Data sources for this measure include:


- California Immunization Registry (CAIR)
- Partnership claims and encounter data
- Data received through the Partnership Clinical Data Repository

Select the measurement year and PCP site you are interested in viewing data for and download to an Excel spreadsheet. Then, select "Crosstab" from the drop-down option in the top right-hand corner of the dashboard. Once the file has downloaded, you can filter the data however you want.

Data from this dashboard can be used to identify members flagged with the following identifiers:

- 1. Very Urgent (members turning two in the upcoming four months)
- 2. Urgent (members turning two in five to seven months)
- 3. To Be Evaluated (members turning two in eight to 21 months)
- 4. Newborn To Be Evaluated (members born in the past three months)

Once the members of focus are identified, you can use the data for outreach to close gaps in care.









Preventive Care Reports

Immunization for Adolescents (IMA):

This dashboard displays a vaccine dose report with immunization data for members in the IMA denominator for the current measurement year and for members not yet in the annual denominator. Data sources for this measure include:


- CAIR
- · Partnership claims and encounter data
- Data received through the Partnership Clinical Data Repository

Select the measurement year and PCP site you are interested in viewing data for and download to an Excel spreadsheet. Then, select "Crosstab" from the drop-down option in the top righthand corner of the dashboard. Once the file has downloaded, you can filter the data however you want.

Data from this dashboard can be used to identify members flagged with the following identifiers:

- 1. Very Urgent (members age 12)
- 2. Urgent (members age 11)
- 3. Priority (members age 10)
- 4. Time Permitting (members age 9)
- 5. Members currently 13 years or older (13+)

Once the members of focus are identified, you can use the data for outreach to close gaps in care.









Preventive Care Reports

Well-Child Visits:

This dashboard displays well-care reports of completed well-child visit data and provides visit visibility for members who are in the denominator for well-child visits in the first 15 months, well-child visits in the first 15-30 months, and child and adolescent well-care measures. The data sources for this measure include Partnership claims and encounter data. It is important to note this data **does not include** the following W15 and W30 measure criteria:


- The allowable gap continuous enrollment
- The children who had well-child visits billed under their mother's CIN
- The 14-day rule

Select the measurement year and PCP site you are interested in viewing data for and download to an Excel spreadsheet. Then, select "Crosstab" from the drop-down option in the top right-hand corner of the dashboard. Once the file has downloaded, you can filter the data however you want.

Data from this dashboard can be used to identify the following members:

- 1. Children turning 15 months who have identified well-child visits via Partnership claims or encounter data. Children with less than six visits can be targeted for outreach for the W15 measure.
- 2. Children aged 3-17 years who have identified well-child visits via Partnership claims or encounter data. Children with zero well-child visits between the ages 3-17 years can be targeted for outreach for the child and adolescent well-care visit measure.


Once the members of focus are identified, you can use the data for outreach to close gaps in care.


